Plan consultation

WP reported that the word “development” had been included in the title of the Plan and the amended plan incorporating the Examiners recommended changes had been submitted to WBC. We will hear shortly from WBC as to when the plan will be considered by the council.

Planning applications

We are now receiving planning applications from WBC covering our Area, in accordance with the Localism Act.

Budget

CD produced some draft figures for consideration. It was agreed that more information about possible printing cost is needed before finalizing the budget. ED agreed to produce some figures.

Pyrford flower show

This will take place on the 8th of July. WBNF will have a joint stand with the RA.

Sheer House Complex planning application

The developers have submitted a new planning application incorporating changes recommended by Natural England. The main change is reduction in the height of the building adjacent to the conservation area of the Station Approach.

Broadoaks (now known by the developer as Broadoaks park)

It was understood the affordable houses are now changed from 32 to 36.

Planning negotiations are still continuing between the developer, the potential school occupier and WBC.

Community Infrastructure Levy

WP to find out more about this and report back to the committee.

West Byfleet recreation ground

The committee has learnt that there may be proposals to build commercial buildings on the recreation ground for leisure use. The committee is very concerned by this development and is trying to find out more about this from WBC.

Next Meeting

Subsequent development
