3. Update from the Chair –

Pyrford forum are now going forward with plans moving to 6 week consultation.

West Byfleet forum now had 257 members, with new members expected from the drop in meeting on 13th April.

Ernest Amoko from Woking Council planning department has offered to give the West Byfleet forum advice if needed.

4. The meeting re funding for the WBFC. The application is for around 8k or which 1.5k has been used or apportioned. Locality will hold back 10%.

Extra funding is available for special projects, all information is on the Locality website.

5. David Fisher presented a report from the Social and Community group (copy attached).

6. Leaflets re the drop in Meeting will be put through letterboxes and displayed around West Byfleet, it is expected to have around 200 people coming to the evening meeting. It was thought that at the meeting that the forum should express their views that nothing should be built on the green belt and the recreational ground must be maintained for education and recreational use. Hedgerows should be protected, and trees replaced if they are removed for any reason. Dodd's Lane must be protected and the area of ancient woodland on the Broad Oaks site. A point of interest was that Rivey Ditch is the boundary of the West Byfleet Forum.
